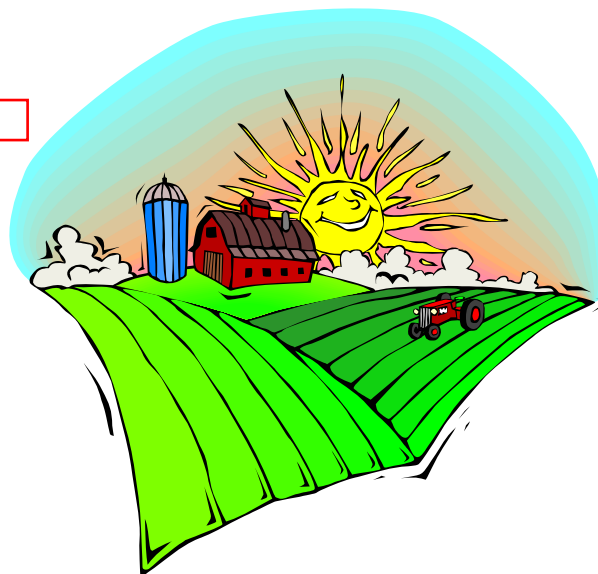
Private Applicator

A private applicator certification is required for anyone applying for a restricted materials pesticide permit, intends to apply pesticides themselves and doesn't hold a QAL or QAC certification.

Qualified Applicator

A person that is licensed under the California Qualified Applicator Licensing program, such as QAL-qualified applicator license (brown card) or QAC-qualified applicator certificate (silver card).

*If your Private Applicator Certification expires this year and you do not get the required Continuing Education hours by December 31st of 2009, you will have to take the new private applicator's exam to get your certificate.



When Does My Private Applicator Certification Expire?

If your last name begins with "A" through "H", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2009**.

If your last name begins with "I" through "Q", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2010**.

If your last name begins with "R" through "Z", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2011**.

Credit Hours:

- All Continuing Education courses are approved for **Laws and Regulations**.
- Each course counts for **2** hours. A total of **12** hours of continuing education credits are available.
