

2008 FLU CLINIC SCHEDULE

The Kings County Health Department will offer influenza vaccines to the following groups at increased risk for influenza-related complications:

Inactivated influenza vaccine:

- › 60 years and older, with or without chronic health conditions
- › Persons ages 2 – 59 with chronic health conditions
- › Children ages 6 – 59 months
- › Women who will be pregnant or have newborns during the influenza season

Fee - \$5.00

Services will not be refused, due to inability to pay.

Who can receive it: Healthy children and adults from 5 – 49 years of age, including most health-care workers and household contacts of most people at high risk for influenza complications.
